

GIFT AID DECLARATION

Increase your gift by 25% at no cost to you!

If you pay UK income tax, we can increase your gift by 25p for every £1 you have given, at no cost to you, through the government Gift Aid scheme – making your gift go even further. Completing this form will enable us to reclaim the tax you have paid on your gift. Please read the notes below, then fill in your name and address, and sign the declaration, returning it to us at the address below as soon as possible.

NOTES:

1. As your declaration covers donations you may make in the future:
 - Please notify the charity if you change your name and address while the declaration is still in force.
 - You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying the charity – it will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.
2. You must have paid, or will pay, an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donation in the tax year.
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income or capital gains equal to the tax that the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1.)
4. Novi Most International will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you give.
5. If you pay tax at a higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
6. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid relief please do contact us. Or you can ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 Gift Aid.
